## SCHOOL SAFETY

- Find an easy way to walk to school or the bus stop. Always walk with siblings, neighbors or a friend.
- Don't talk to strangers, go anywhere with them, or take anything from them.
- Know your address and phone number. Program the police telephone number into your cell phone 1-714-593-4485.



## CHILD SAFETY TIPS

- Pay close attention to what your child tells you about friends, the neighborhood, or fears. Thoughtful listening builds trust, a key to growing up safe.
- Make sure you know your child's friends as well as their friend's parents.
- Before your children go to another home, ask the adults there whether they have guns or alcohol in the home, and whether these are securely and safely stored.
- Visit the neighborhood with your child. Find out where they feel unsafe. Work with neighbors to address problems. Confirm safe places to seek help.
- Set up clear rules for play after school, on weekends, and during the summer or at holidays. Review rules with your child.
- Urge kids to play in areas that are less susceptible to approach by strangers. Be a helping adult. Let kids know that they can tell you anything. Mentor a child who needs adult support.

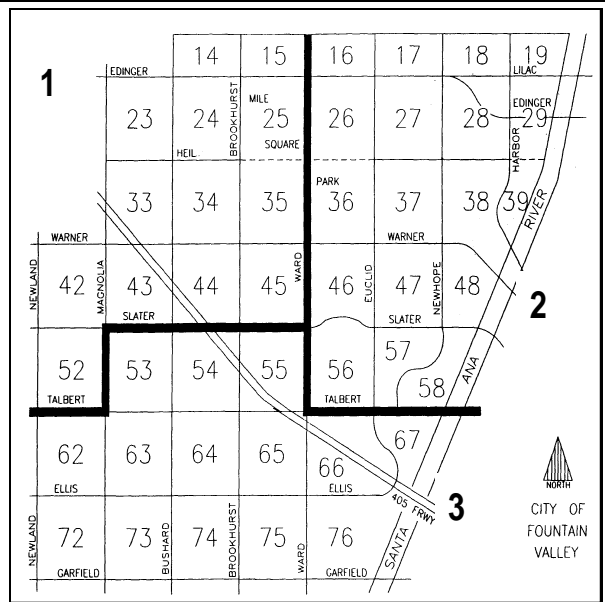

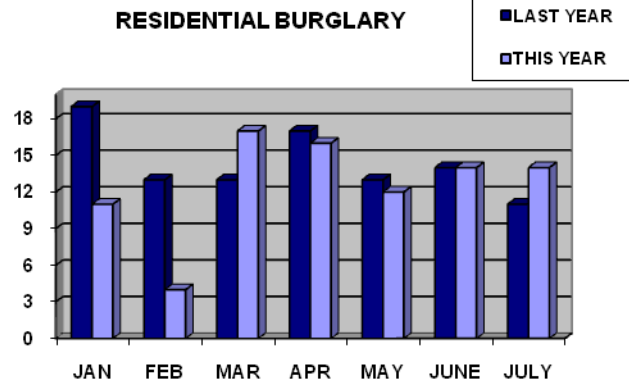

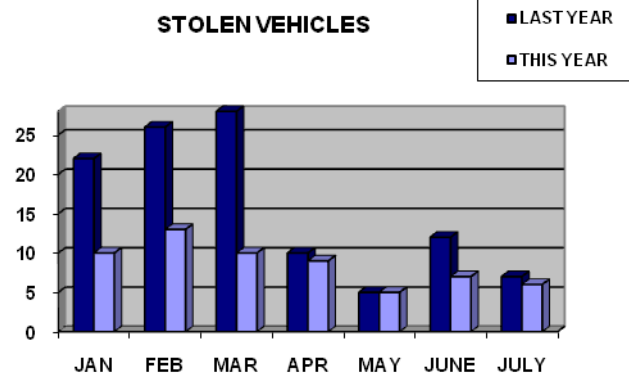
